Some Reminders

Here's a checklist of the items that need to be taken care of as soon as possible.

1. **Hot Lunch Order Forms for September**—If you didn't place your September Hot Lunch order yet, you may do so until THURSDAY. Extra forms are available in the school office if you misplaced yours.
2. **After School Sports Program**—begins next week for students in grades 1-5. Participants in grades meet on Monday and Friday; participants in grades 3-5 meet Tuesday and Thursday. The first sport to learn fundamentals and skills is VOLLEYBALL. The program is seven weeks and meets from 3:00-4:15 p.m.
3. **Immunization Records**—*must* be updated and on file in our office by **August 31**. Any student who still does not have updated shot records will not be permitted to attend class until we have it on file. This is a State of Arizona requirement.
4. **Fry's Cool Cash Program** officially begins September 1. All you have to do is bring of copy of the school's barcode to the Customer Service desk along with your Fry's card to be registered. Each time thereafter you shop at Fry's a percentage of your bill goes to the school. Our goal is to earn \$2000 this year.
