1. **Fry's Cool Cash Program** officially began September 1. Fry's has a copy of the school's barcode at the Customer Service desk. All you need is your Fry's card to be registered. Just let them know you wish to register for Cross of Christ Christian School. Each time thereafter you shop at Fry's a percentage of your bill goes to the school. Our goal is to earn \$2000 this year.
2. **General Mills Boxtop Program**—Just clip off the box top label from select General Mills products and give them to your child's teacher. We're having classroom contests to earn a chance for a jean day in October!
3. **Heifer Project**— After four weeks, **more than \$700** has been received in chapel offerings for Heifer International! Each class has a goal to earn enough money to purchase, honeybees, llamas, goats, or other animals for people in Third World countries. Prayerfully support this mission opportunity that continues throughout the month of September.
4. **Birthday Books**— parents, grandparents and friends may stop in the office or go up to the library and choose a book to be presented to a child in honor of his/her birthday, half birthday, baptismal birthday, or other special event. A placard will be placed inside the book with an inscription of the event.
